David Strongin was born in 1993 in Tel-Aviv, and started his violin studies at the age of six.

He is granted the America-Israel Cultural Foundation (AICF) scholarships since 2005. He has performed in the Excellence Musicians Unit of the JMC, where he participated in many chamber music groups with whom he recorded for the Israeli Radio. In 2005 and 2009 he is the first and the second price winner of the "Mordehai Turgeman" competition.

As a soloist David has played with the "Israel Chamber Orchestra Ramat-Gan", the "Raanana Symphonic Orchestra" and the "Istanbul Symphonic Orchestra".

David Strongin has participated in some festivals and performed with various chamber music ensembles, such as the "Israel Chamber Music Club" and the "Young Euro Classic Festival" in Berlin (2010).

In 2008 he was invited as a soloist to play with maestro Shlomo Mintz in project "Violins of Hope" in Jerusalem.

He has got many master classes including Ida Haendel, Shlomo Mintz, Zachar Bron, Mirian Fried and others.

As a second instrument David studies also the piano.

Since 2009 he studies at the "Hochschule für Musik und Theater" in Hannover with professor Adam Kostecki.
